The honourable M.L.A, Mr. Jagarnath Mahto felt that there is not any C.B.S.E School in the radius of 40 kms. The villages, surrounding to Dumri are populated by the caste of mainly backward caste, scheduled caste, scheduled tribe and muslim. So he gave this responsibility to Dr. Shamsul Haque, Principal, P.N. Inter Collage Isri Bazar, to stand an English medium school at Jamtara,(Dumri).

Dr. Haque started an English medium school at Jamtara (Dumri) in 2008. The educationists and the Politicians encouraged and helped him very much where and when he required. This school was named "Progressive Public School." In the Month of February Annual day of the school is celebrated every year.

Needless to say that the people of this locality took keen interest in the school. They arranged several meeting to meet the initial requirement of the school. among from the local persons who keep interest in education, a local committee was made.

To run this school smoothly and remove the economic problem, a Trust was made in 2010. Dr. Shamsul Haque got the Trust registered in the district registry office Giridih. He and his wife leased more than 2 acres of land to the Trust. This Trust was named Nasimul Memorial Educational & Welfare Trust, in the memory of their heavenly son, Nasimul Haque . We feel pride to say that this school is imparting education to the poor people of surrounding villages. The management committee tries to bring the helpless children to school and the members of the Trust and M.C fulfill their essential

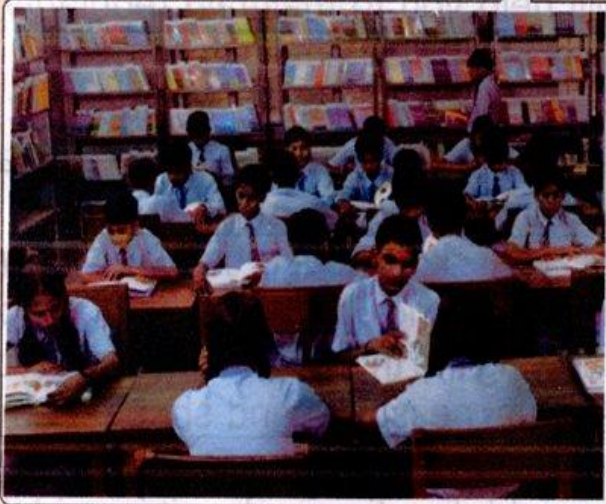

ATTENDANCE

1. 75% attendance is essential for promotion to The next higher class.
2. No leave is granted except on prior application from parents/guardians for genuine reasons.
3. In case of sickness a medical certificate from a registered. Medical practitioner has to be submitted.
4. Repeated absence Without leave or unexplained leave for ten consecutive days render the student liable to have his name struk off the rolls.
5. It is compulsory for students to attend the school on the first and the last day after Summer Vacation, Puja Vacation and Winter Vacation.
6. Attendance of a student during all the examinations is a must. Absence in any examination will certainly affect the annual results.

HEALTH CARE

Students are made aware of the health through Various programs like World Health Day, Health check-up Camps, Healthy Baby Show, AIDS Day, Cancer Awareness Etc. First Aid facility is also available.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

School imparts education in English Medium because it offers greater opportunities, however sufficient stress is laid on Hindi , Sanskrit as well as urdu.



COMPUTER EDUCATION

The school is providing Computer Education from Class 1 onwards. It is just to keep the students in touch with the knowledge of 21st century.





HOBBY CLASS

TRANSPORT

1. School transport is available at reasonable rates. Admission to the school does not guarantee the availability of school transport facilities.
2. No request to dis-continue bus facility will be entertained during the academic year.
3. Withdrawal from the school transport can be done in the beginning of the session only one month's prior notice or one month's charge in lieu there of.
4. School Bus user must carry their Bus Badges/card every day, failing which they may not be allowed to board the bus.





5. While all precaution shall be taken for the safety of the students. The parent should note that the school bears no liability whatsoever for any injuries sustained by the in accident or otherwise travelling by the school bus.
6. School transport fee can be enhanced in between the session in case of hike in diesel rates.



ADMISSION RULES

1. Registration : Registration / Admission forms for new admission are available from the school office along with the prospectus at a cost of Rs. 150/-, Selection is made on the basis of test and interview so as to determine the capability of the child to pursue the prescribed courses of studies.
2. Documents required at the time of admission
 - (i) Birth Certificate
 - (ii) Character Certificate
 - (iii) Transfer Certificate issued by the competent authority
 - (iv) Medical Fitness Certificate
 - (v) Two Stamp Size coloured photographs
 - (vi) Migration Certificate.
 - (vii) Photocopy of Aadhar Card.

IDENTITY CARD

An Identity Card bearing a passport size photograph and the address of the student will remain in his/her custody all the time.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

1. All students must possess school diary, text books, note books, stationers etc.
2. Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to the school. The school will not be responsible for any such loss.
3. Students must come in school uniform.
4. The must be clean, neat and tidy.
5. Students should obey House Captains and other students on duty.
6. Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours unless the parents/guardians whose signatures are on th admission forms and the school diary come in person.
7. Any damage to the school property by the student will have to be bear by the student's parents/ guardians.
8. The school reserves the right to take stern action even to strike off the name of the students from the school rolls who are found guilty of misconduct.
9. Obey the rules of library and laboratories.





GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

DO'S

- * Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher and check the diary daily for Home Work and the teacher's remarks, if any.
- * Sign the test copies/papers as and when sent home. Collect the progress report card from the class teacher personally.
- * See that your ward has all the text books, items of stationery, craft materials etc. right in the beginning of the session.
- * Ensure that all the books and note books are covered with brown paper and labeled properly.
- * Ensure that your ward comes to school in
- * Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair and clean nails.
- * Send the children regularly and punctually to school No absence will be permitted without a leave application and late comes will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- * Parents must attend the Parent Teacher Meet.
- * Pay the fees as per schedule.
- * Intimate the school in case of change in address and telephone number etc.
- * Help in the developmental work of the school whenever necessary.

DON'T'S

- Do not send the child to school in case of an infectious disease. A medical certificate should be furnished from a medical authority at the time of rejoining the school after illness.
- Do not walk into the class room or meet teacher in the class room. please see the teacher with prior appointment through Principal.
- Do not visit the teachers at their residence.
- Do not send money or valuable articles with the students. The school takes no responsibility in case they are lost.
- Students shall not be allowed to leave the school campus before the school is over.





INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF FEE :

- » Last date for acceptance of school fee is the 10th of the month.
- » Late fee deposit fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged with the fee of the month up to 10th of the Month.
- » Fee will not be accepted after the 10th of the Month.
- » Arrears of the fee of the last month will be accepted up to 10th of the next month with a fine Rs. 100/- only.
- » Name of the default will be struck off the school rolls in case of non payment of the fee for two months as per rules given above without any further intimation to the concerned.
- » In such cases arrear of two months will be accepted with the re-admission fine of Rs. 250/- along with the fee of the current month up to the 10th of the month with the permission of the principal only on genuine grounds.
- » Advance fee on quarterly, Half yearly and Annual basis is also accepted. Fee detail is available on a separate sheet.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students must reach the school at least five minutes before the time fixed for assembly.
2. Any damage done in the class or in the premises will have to be made good by the parents of the child concerned.
3. It is strictly compulsory for every child to come to the school in full uniform with well polished shoes.
4. Students are required to bring books and note books to the school according to the time table.
5. Parents are expected to co-operate in the working of the school by enforcing regularity, discipline and taking general interest in the progress of their children. They should check the students diary regularly and note the teacher's remarks etc.
6. If the students or the parents misbehave with any member of the staff, the school has every right to expel the student from the school.
7. Parents or guardians are not allowed to disturb or discuss with teacher during active teaching hours.





8. Any communication (Request or Suggestion) made by the parents should be addressed to the Principal and not to the class teachers.
9. Parents are requested to inform the changes of their address immediately.
10. Only those applications for leave are considered to be genuine which are duly attested by the father or the guardian of the student.
11. If a child is sick for more than three days a medical certificate has to be furnished along with the leave application.
12. Students are advised not to purchase any article or food from un-authorized dealers at or near the school premises.
13. Gold ornaments, jewellery and costly articles should not be brought to the school.
14. Every student should bring his/her diary in the school dialy.
15. Students should greet their teachers when they meet them. They should remember that a school is judged by their conduct.
16. Students should get their Progress reports signed by their guardians within three days of receipt.
13. The children should be regular and punctual in attending the school.
14. Due attention shall be paid to personal hygiene. The students will see that their nails are well filed, teeth clean and hair properly clipped and combed.
15. Courtesy and respect should mark their dealings with all. Teachers should be appropriately greeted.
16. The school should be kept neat and clean. The school property should be preserved with care Furniture and walls should not be disfigured.
17. No leave for part of the day will be allowed.
18. No leave for the whole day will be granted unless parents give a leave note which is sanctioned by the principal.
19. The parents should meet, class teachers only on Saturadys or by prior appointment through the Principal to avoid any disturbance during the class hours.
20. The school dues must be paid in time.
21. The parents are requested to see that their children do not carry money or valuables in school.
22. All tiffin boxes, water bottles etc. should be well marked with the name and class of the child concerned.
